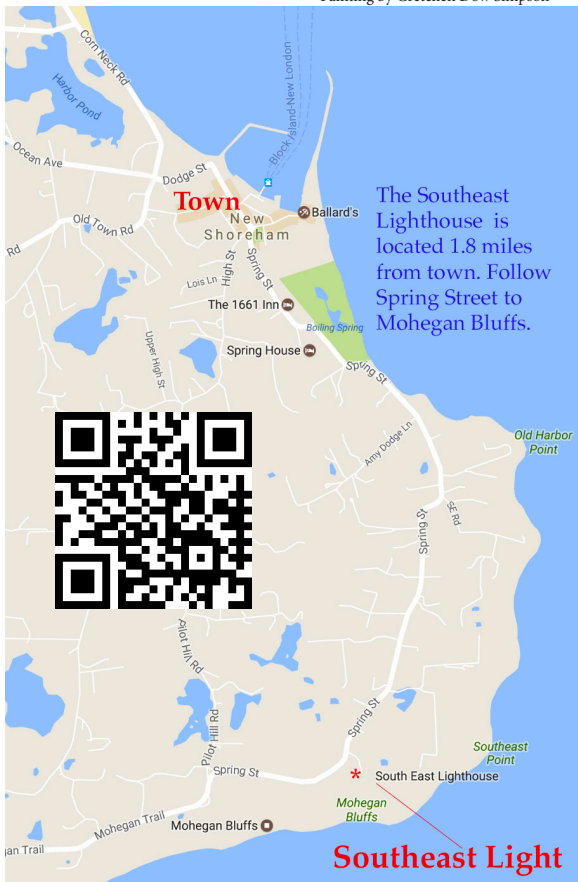

Southeast Lighthouse

A National Historic Landmark

Built in 1873 / Moved in 1993



Hours: 10am to 4pm daily / Late June thru Labor Day
Weekends only in early Summer and Fall



Admission:

Free: Museum Gift Shop and Information Desk.

Museum exhibits:

Adults \$10./ Seniors, Active Military, and Students: \$8.

Children 9 and under: Free with accompanying adult.

Lighthouse Tower Tour (Guided access only):

Adults \$15 / Seniors, Active Military, and Students: \$12.

Children 9 and under: Free with accompanying adult.

Combined Museum Exhibits & Lighthouse Tower Tour:

Adults \$20./ Seniors, Active Military, and Students: \$16.

The Southeast Lighthouse was moved back from the edge of Mohegan Bluff in 1993, the result of a 10-year effort that required 3 Acts of Congress and \$2 million.
