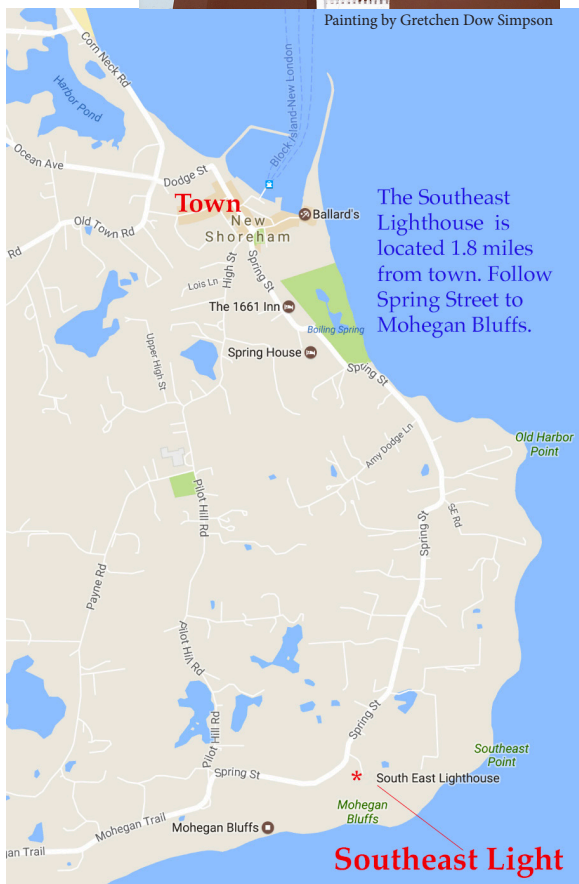

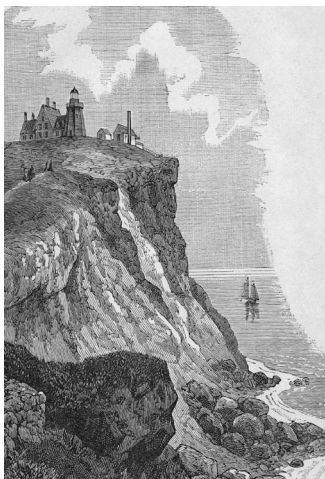
# Southeast Lighthouse

**Hours:** 10am to 4pm daily / Late June thru Labor Day  
Weekends only in early Summer and Fall

Free to Shop, Lighthouse Tower Exhibit and Information Desk.

## **Escorted Tower Tours:**

Adults \$10.

Seniors and Children (ages 7 to 16) \$5.

Children 6 years and under are Free with accompanying adult.
